


# A new path to becoming a Police Constable

You will receive comprehensive training and practical experience on the job for two years. Unlike other routes, the IPLDP+ does not include university study as part of the programme.

## **Training structure**

Your journey will begin with a 20-week initial learning period at our Tally Ho! Training Centre, followed by operational coaching and training in the wider force. Once you have successfully completed the programme you will be able to consider further opportunities of progression and specialism within the force.

## Apply today and shape your future

Join West Midlands Police and embark on an exciting career in policing. Whether you choose the IPLDP+ programme or one of our other pathways, you will receive excellent training and support from our dedicated team.

Applicants must have a Level 2 English qualification and a Level 3 qualification (2 A levels or equivalent) to apply.

Alternatively, 12 months relevant policing experience will be accepted in place of the Level 3 qualification. Starting salary is £28,551 rising yearly to over £46,044 after 7 years.
